WHAT: Another Suspect Caught Dumping in the 3700 Block of Lucille

Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Houston Police Department's Environmental Investigations Division are seeking the public's assistance with any information on a suspect illegally dumping her trash in a vacant lot.

The suspect was caught on a surveillance camera in the 3700 block of Lucille emptying the back of her pickup truck into a vacant lot on August 22, 2007. The lot was already littered with an old mattress and other debris.

The suspect is a White or Hispanic female with dark hair in a pony tail and bangs. The suspect is driving a light colored extended cab pickup truck with a bug guard and some sort of design going from the door to the back of the truck. The design is in shades of blue. If you look closely at the picture you can see another woman sitting in the passenger seat of the truck. She has long dark hair in a braid.

Attached is a photo of the suspect.

Illegal Dumping costs the citizens of Houston nearly \$5 million each year. Anyone who might recognize this woman or her truck is urged to call Crime Stoppers.
